He is a versatile and consummate artist, whose creative works have joined the constellation of art collections in India and abroad. He broke fresh ground in representational and abstract art, bridging the divide between them. Small wonder that even children besides art critics and connoisseurs can relate to and appreciate his splash of colors and different brush-less strokes.

His paintings touch many themes and the hearts of beholders. Hailing from a seashore village in Nagapattinam, Tamilnadu, India, he has experienced the songs of birds and the beauty of nature.

A product of the Kumbakonam College of Fine Arts, he gained ambidextrous skill to transfer his nature, cultural and spiritual experience onto the white canvas.

It is not only with the imagination that he creates his masterpieces, but also from varied experiences – abject poverty in childhood that forced him to drink only water for lunch; the joy of fishing in calm waters and the knack of tending a herd of cows. Add to this his interdisciplinary skills – folk singer, tabalist and writer.

In 2006, he founded Ample Arts Academy in Chennai. He is a visiting faculty in a reputed institution. His paintings are exhibited in Solo and Group shows across India.



*Badmaphushan* was state first in the junior under 17 category of the Department of Post – 2022 "Varied Cultural Heritage of Tamilnadu". Also he is an honorable nominee in the international competition "EARTH-X-2022 Eco Art Contest".
